

HONORABLE MENTION OF AUTODESK HK BIM AWARDS 2020

The project is a fast-track one with 39 months' time to design and construct the proposed desalination plant within budget. The involvement of multiple stakeholders from six countries/regions makes it challenging to coordinate offline due to conflicting time zones/locations/common platform issues. The improved centralization of project information in a common data environment (CDE) with BIM360 ensured efficient design approval process.

As opposed to the traditional FTP server-based approach, CDE was entirely online and allowed each discipline to instantly gather synchronized information with up-to-date models which in turn is federated out to the master BIM model. This greatly optimized the decision-making process. With 3D model coordination and production being performed on online platform with BIM 360 Design Collaboration and Coordination,

project delivery within time and budget is deemed possible. All related stakeholders pick up the skills and are capable of using BIM within 3 months to facilitate the design coordination process, development of construction work sequence, and commenting and approval of submissions.



WSD BEST WORKS SITE COMPETITION 2020

The site has participated in WSD Best Works Site Competition 2020. The Competition was organized by WSD in order to motivate staff who is supervising consultant managed contracts towards continual improvement in performance and service quality.





This is also a good opportunity to foster staff relationship and teamwork. During the site visit on 24 June 2020, the selection panel led by Mr. C.C. Lok (CE/C) was impressed by the site team's strong morale in delivering the project at the best in every aspect.




